KINDER: OCEANS ALIVE!*

Incoming Kindergarteners will experience the world's oceans while building Kindergarten skills! Skills such as letter and number recognition, counting, phonics, recognizing and creating patterns, graphing and more will be explored in fun filled activities. Students will express ideas orally and work in group and partner discussions. We will also be exploring Kinder basics as we learn playground rules, develop classroom expectations, and work on getting along with others all while building self-confidence and familiarity with Kindergarten. All students must be completely potty trained.

1ST & 2ND GRADES: WILD ABOUT LEARNING!*

Incoming first and second graders will explore various habitats throughout the world and the plants and animals that reside in them. Students will learn essential math concepts through hands-on inquiry activities. Through collaboration and research, they will discover answers to their many questions. We will look at relationships in nature and learn about cooperation and respect. Students will enjoy going on this adventure around the world studying art, science and math.

3RD & 4TH GRADES: MUMMIES & MORE!*

Have you ever wondered about how the ancient Egyptians created the pyramids? How they mummified the ancient pharaohs and many other ancient mysteries? This course is a cross-disciplinary class that offers history, math, science, reading, writing, art and music. Come and explore.

5TH & 6TH GRADES: YO, YO, YOSEMITE!*

Who said your child can't go camping this summer? Your mini park ranger will take a classroom journey through California's most treasured national park, Yosemite. They will explore the park's ecosystems and biomes. Mini rangers will become fascinated as they interpret and analyze data and explore the rich and complex history of this majestic wonderland. We will have fun camp challenge days where students will work collaboratively to complete camp-oriented tasks like designing and setting up tents, competing in survival challenges, and participating in nature-based experiences. Finally, what would camp be without good ol' s'mores? Yes, we will have that too! Students can't miss out on this rich, cross-disciplinary experience where we will learn science, math, art, reading, engineering, technology and history all in one bonfire blowout (without the fire, of course).

7TH & 8TH GRADES: iCAMP*

Incoming 7th and 8th graders will enjoy this hands-on technology based class. Using laptops, iPads and iPods and iPhones, students will explore the world of coding. Prospective computer programmers and gamers will utilize technology through coding and interactive math application for 21st Century Learning. Students will use specific apps and games that support and enhance classroom practices. Students will have fun and not realize they are learning in the process with apps and games such as Minecraft, Exploration, Prezi and many others.
